

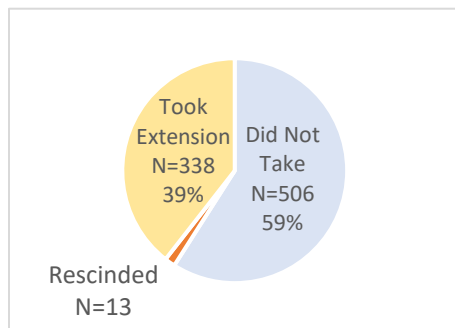


## Covid Extension Fact Sheet

June 2022

The Covid extension allows any faculty member on path during 2020 (~854 individuals) to take a one-year extension, effectively stopping the clock for that year. They may decide to later rescind this extension and go back to their original clock. After two years, the extension has been widely used.

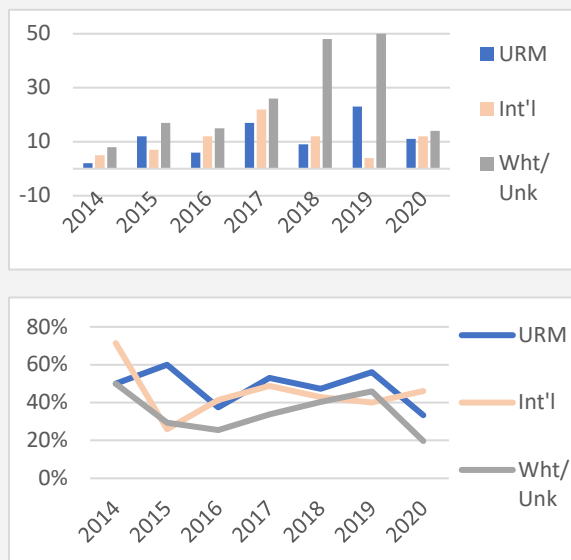
**1.** Many faculty members have accepted it. Few have given it back.



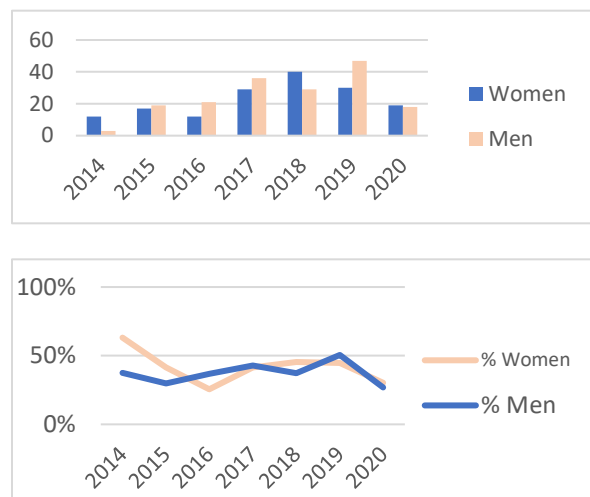
**2.** Participation was widespread, spanning nearly all units and with similar proportions.

**3.** URM and International faculty members accepted it at higher rates than White/Unknown counterparts.



**4.** Both male and female faculty members accepted the extension.



**5.** It helped! In the 2014 cohort, 6 achieved tenure in 2022 while 8 are still on path. The 8-year tenure rate for the 2014 cohort is 59%.
