

**Executive Summary** 



The COVID extension allows any faculty member on the tenure path during 2020 (~851 individuals) to take a one-year extension, effectively stopping the clock for that year. They may decide to later rescind this extension and go back to their original clock. After three years, there are 350 (41%) faculty members who took the extension. A total of 502 faculty members did not accept the extension or have rescinded the extension.

### **Current Status of 350 Faculty Members**

#### Took the Extension

Of the 350 faculty members with the extension, **225 are still working towards tenure** at the University. A total of 52 faculty members (15%) have earned tenure to date.

## **Current Status of 501 Faculty Members**


No Extension or Rescinded the Extension

Of the 501 faculty members who did not take the extension or rescinded the extension, **206 are still working towards tenure** at the University. A total of 227 faculty members (45%) have earned tenure to date.
